



Approximate Living cost:

- Apply early! Although places are available for 2019, these will go quickly due to the high demand for University accommodation.





Important Information

Catering Arrangements

The fully catered residences (Weerona and International House) offer 19 meals per week served in a common Dining Room. The cost of this food service is included in the weekly rental fee.

**The weekly rental fee at Campus East does not include the cost of food. Residents can purchase meals from the dining hall and from the on-site cafe, which is open throughout the day. There are limited catering facilities for those living in the flexi-catered units. These include a small communal kitchen, two BBQs, nearby supermarkets in Fairy Meadow shopping centre, a new hot meal vending machine, and microwaves.

At self-catered residences, residents prepare and cook their own meals in their studio, unit, or shared kitchen.

Application Fee: \$26*

A non-refundable Application Fee is payable at the time you submit your application online. Your application will not be considered until such time as this fee is paid.

Residential Fee Pre-Payment: \$500

This pre-payment is a non-refundable deposit which reserves your place in accommodation. The pre-payment is made through the accommodation portal at the time of accepting your offer of accommodation.

If you have failed courses in Wollongong, you need to discuss with your head of program first by sending an email with choosing the 2 option following below:

- You will extend in Wollongong for 1 semester/ 1 year, to completed the failed course in Wollongong. Eventhough only 1 course.
- Comeback to BINUS and doing the single degree in BINUS only (not get the degree from Wollongong).
